As provided for in the Criminal Justice Act Plan for the Eastern District of Washington (please review), applications to reapply for placement on the CJA Panel are due every THREE (3) years and will besubmitted to the CJA Panel Committee. APPLICATIONS FOR REAPPOINTMENT ARE DUE BY DECEMBER 31 OF THE PANEL MEMBER'S FINAL YEAR OF THEIR CURRENT APPOINTMENT TERM. The CJA Panel Committee typically meets in January. Prior to reappointment on the CJA Panel, the Panel Committee will request comments from the District Judges.

By completing this form, you agree to be placed on a list of counsel available for appointment to represent indigent Defendants in criminal cases in this District. In most instances you would be asked to accept cases in the city which you reside; however, on rare occasions, you may be called upon to accept a case originating in another city - Spokane, Yakima or Richland.
