ACCESSING SEALED DOCUMENTS

Introduction

Users will now be able to click on the **document number link** from the Notice of Electronic Filing (NEF) and view/print/save sealed documents. **It is important to note this access may not apply to all sealed documents.** Some documents will remain non-accessible.

If a sealed document can be accessed, CM/ECF must determine that you have permission to access the document. Validation is based on counsel entering their **ECF Login and Password** after clicking on the document number hyperlink (see below). **Once the document is accessed, you should print as many copies as you need or save the PDF for future access. Any subsequent access from the NEF will require you to pay PACER fees for the document, if applicable.**



The following is a list of sealed documents that can be accessed from the NEF.


- Sealed Documents which you or the Court have e-filed

<p>4. Access warning.</p> <p>A. After ECF validates your access, a warning screen is displayed to inform you the document can only be accessed by court users and the applicable party.</p> <p>B. [Click] on the [view Document] button</p>	
<p>5. Document display.</p> <p>The restricted document is displayed.</p> <div data-bbox="240 527 769 747" style="border: 1px solid black; padding: 5px; margin: 10px 0;"> <p>NOTE: You can now save the PDF for future access and print one or more copies.</p> <p>If you try to access the document again through the NEF or via PACER, you will incur PACER charges.</p> </div>	

Service

You will have access to sealed documents which you have e-filed, however, you must continue to serve sealed documents on opposing counsel in paper.
