15 Judge's Report and Recommendation must be filed within the time provided in
16 L.Cr.R. 11. The assigned District Judge will act on the Magistrate Judge's Report
17 and Recommendation; decide whether to accept any plea agreement; adjudicate
18 guilt; and determine and impose sentence.
