GENERAL ORDER

Disclosure of Grand Jury Material to the Defendant

Federal Rule of Criminal Procedure 6(e)(3)(E) provides that:

The court may authorize disclosure – at a time, in a manner, and subject to any other conditions that it directs – of a grand jury matter:

(i) preliminarily to or in connection with a judicial proceeding. . .

To avoid the necessity of individual motions and orders in every criminal case and to conserve scarce judicial resources, the following General Order of this Court is entered.

1                   **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:**

- 3                   1.       Without the necessity of any further order of the Court and pursuant to
- 4                   Fed. R. Crim. P. 6(e)(3)(E)(i), the United States is authorized to
- 5                   disclose to the defense for its use in connection with the judicial
- 6                   proceeding, any grand jury subpoenaed documents and transcripts of
- 7                   witnesses testifying before the grand jury, after the Indictment has
- 8                   been returned in each criminal case.
- 9                   2.       Circumstances falling outside the parameters of this Order shall be
- handled on a case-by-case basis by appropriate motion.
- 10                  3.       The District Court Executive is ordered to enter this Order, provide
- copies to the United States Attorney's Office, the Federal Defenders
- of Eastern Washington and Idaho, Criminal Justice Act panel
- attorneys, and any other interested person who requests a copy.
