The United States Probation/Pretrial Services Office in Eastern Washington is pleased to announce the availability of video conferencing with the Benton County Jail.

Procedure to arrange for a video conference interview at the Benton County Jail: Attorneys are asked to contact the Benton County Jail directly at CUFrontDesk@co.benton.wa.us to schedule a video conference with federal inmates housed in the Benton County Jail.

In the Email, please provide the following necessary information to arrange the interview:

√Requestor's/attorney's name

√Requestor's/attorney's phone number or email address

√Inmate's full name

 $\sqrt{\text{Preferred date and time for interview}}$

 $\sqrt{\text{Alternate date and time for interview}}$

 $\sqrt{\text{Anticipated length of interview}}$

Benton County Jail would prefer a 24-hour notice to schedule an interview, but will do their best to accommodate a shorter notice.
