WASHINGTON LOCAL CIVIL RULE 16(a)(5)(C)

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(a) and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 83, the Court has adopted Local Civil Rule 16(a)(5)(C), allowing a presiding judge in selected cases to refer matters for mediation to a magistrate judge, a district judge, or a bankruptcy judge designated by the Court.

As a component of the referral of these matters for mediation, the Court specifically authorizes such magistrate judges, district judges and bankruptcy judges, as part of the performance of their judicial duties, to act as settlement judges through judge hosted settlement conferences.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that all magistrate judges, district judges and bankruptcy judges of this district are designated as possible judicial neutrals pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 651-658 and are authorized to act as settlement judges
