SCHEDULE FOR CALENDAR
YEAR 2025

The offices of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Washington, including those of the Clerk of Court and Probation Services, will be closed on Thursday, November 27, 2025, in observance of the Thanksgiving Day Federal Holiday, Thursday, December 25, 2025, in observance of the Christmas Holiday, and Thursday, January 1, 2026, in observance of the New Year's Day Holiday.

In addition, in recognition of the exemplary effort and work performance of the District's court professionals throughout the duration of the FY2026 shutdown of the federal government, these same offices of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Washington, will be open, but operations will be limited, on:

- Friday, November 28, 2025;

1 • Friday, December 26, 2025; and

2 • Friday, January 2, 2026.

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4 The Court's CM/ECF system will be available for electronic filing
5 throughout this holiday schedule. Those seeking to make in-person filings or
6 payments on November 28, 2025, December 26, 2025, and January 2, 2026, are
7 directed to leave such materials in designated drop-boxes at the Court Security
8 Officer locations (guard stations) in the entryway of each courthouse. The Court
9 encourages electronic filings made through the CM/ECF filing system, use of the
10 electronic payment system, and use of mail and delivery services on these dates.

11 The District Court Executive is directed to transmit copies of this General
12 Order to the United States Attorney, the United States Marshal Service, the Clerk
13 of the Bankruptcy Court, the Federal Public Defender, the General Services
14 Administration, the federal bar and post this General Order to the Court's public
15 website.
