YAKIMA ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 20-04

ORDER REQUIRING FACE COVERINGS/MASKS AND SOCIAL DISTANCING IN THE WILLIAM O. DOUGLAS FEDERAL BUILDING

WHEREAS, the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and other public health authorities have advised taking precautions to slow the spread of COVID-19, including the use of face coverings or masks (hereafter "masks") in public settings, and in consultation with the Facility Security Committee for the William O. Douglas Federal Building, it is hereby:

1. **ORDERED** that effective immediately, all persons seeking entry to, or occupying, the William O. Douglas Federal Building in Yakima, Washington must wear a mask. The mask, when worn, must completely conceal the wearer's nose and mouth at all times.
